

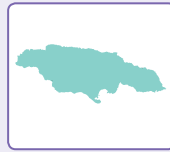
## Travel Scenario Card

### Travel Arrangements:

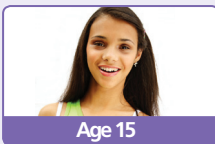
- > Jamila and Mia are sisters. They live in the UK with their parents and are travelling to their maternal home for the first time on their own to visit family.

### Travel Arrangements:

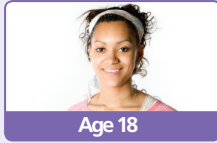
- > Cassia has spent many holidays in Brazil with her family, but this time is planning to travel alone to see friends she's not seen since their last family holiday 4 years ago.

### Travel Arrangements:

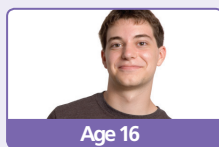
- > Adrien has just finished University and is planning to travel back to France to celebrate with his family.

### Travel Arrangements:

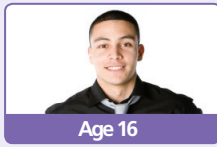
- > Katie and her three best friends are looking forward to a cheap break to any where as long as it has sun, beach, bars and some hot young men.

## Travel Arrangements:

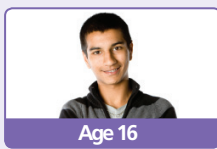
- > Jamal wants to travel to the US to broaden his experience before deciding what to do next.

## Travel Arrangements:

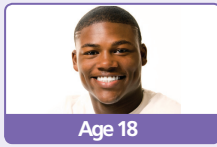
- > Madan is travelling to India to visit his cousins. It is the first time he has travelled to India alone, although he has been every year with his family for as long as he can remember.

### Travel Arrangements:

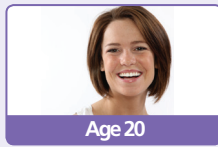
- > Ethan and Clare met at college, they have been seeing each other for nearly a year and are planning their first holiday together.
